GENEROUS DONATION RECEIVED!

On July 11, 2020, the Amite County Historical and Genealogical Society was presented a generous donation from the Resource Conservation and Development Program to be used toward the restoration project of the Little Red School House. Built in 1853, by the Reverend Richard Shirk as a part of the Amite Female Seminary, the building was originally a music room. During the War Between the States, Union forces marched into Liberty and burned all the buildings that made up the Seminary save one- the music room. The Little Red School House, as the music room is known today, has served as a classroom and library for students several times through the decades. Most anyone from Liberty over the age of 60 has a story about a school activity that took place in the Little Red School House.

The Amite County Board of Supervisors offered the Amite County Historical and Genealogical Society the use of the building as its headquarters and research library prior to the county's Bicentennial Celebration in 2009. The Society has worked with the supervisors through the years to help maintain the building. In 2016, society members noticed that the paint was peeling from the bricks on the front of the building and began looking into the cause. It was determined that water was standing on the east side of the building and leaching into the bricks making the actual bricks peel and crumble. The society contacted the Department of Archives and History for advice on what could and could not be done to the building and a plan was developed for stabilizing and repairing the water damage. Other damage was discovered such as a rotted post supporting the front gallery, rotted wood on the window casements and bubbled paint on the inside walls to name a few.

Funds from memberships were committed to the repairs of the building along with the proceeds from book, holiday card sales and donations earmarked for the building fund. The society was able to raise approximately \$12,000 in this manner over the last two years. Limited funds meant projects had to be prioritized and work on Phase 1 did begin. The most pressing problem was to address the moisture that was seeping into the bricks and causing them to disintegrate. A French drain to divert the water has been installed and the building has begun to dry out. The donation from the Resource Conservation and Development Program will make it possible to complete the most pressing repairs that will stabilize the building and prevent further decay. Phase 2 and 3 which will restore the building and add climate control will require additional fundraising. We are very grateful to the RCDP for their assistance in helping us begin to preserve this beloved Amite County landmark.
