Minutes of April 13, 2013 meeting

The 1870 census recorded on September 9 and 10, 1870, by A Parker would indicate the population of the town of Liberty was two hundred. About one-fourth, forty nine, were farm laborers and three were day laborers; sixteen were at school; four paupers; four cooks, and one washer. M. E. Crawford, A. M. Hazlewood, and Emma Washburn (all females) were teachers; P. P. Faust and E. M. Davis were listed as Citizens; Henry Webb was a blacksmith; Edward Hicks was a tanner; D. C. Bramlett and B. F. Johns were lawyers; M. S. Shirk, J. A. Godfrey, and A. Blackburn were ministers; Charles Carroll was a druggist; Dr. J. R. Sample was the physician living in town; R. S. McLain and W. D. Anderson were D. G. Merchants and R. S. Raiford was a merchant.; Allen T. Avery, J. R. Williams, D. A. Faust, N. Garrow, and H. S. Barksdale were farmers living in town; J. E. W. Davis was D. G. Clerk; David Rowell was fisherman & trapper; C. E. Washburn and J. B. Manchester were carpenters; and H. J. Lilly was a painter. Residents not born in Mississippi were born in Maine, North and South Carolina, Indiana, Kentucky, Ohio, Virginia, Louisiana, and New York. The oldest woman, Delph Carroll, was born in Virginia and oldest man, Harry Day, was born in Kentucky. Both were eighty years old.
